 - 3. The disciples in the 11th hour hour so that their patience can produce faith in the future.
 - 3. To change something in you that needs changing
- 1. If God who is Lord of all is working, we need to work too. And if we are weak in something, we'll feel it. Arguments, or failures, or discomfort are all signs that we are weak in something and need to pray and work on something.
- 1. Zaccheus who was the most sinful and hated, when Christ visited Him he said I'll give fourfold to anyone who I took from. His greed was cured. Also he invited all of the other tax collectors to his house as well. His evil relationships were cured.
